

What is a Collection?

A collection is an editorially-controlled grouping of content about a subject, a date, a Center, or even a content author. Each element of the collection is selected, organized, and maintained by an administrator.

You can think of a collection as a “window display” in a storefront and a window dresser chooses the items that go together for informational or marketing purposes.

A collection provides a focused and clear presentation of information geared toward a particular audience and topic. Collections can be deployed quickly, making them a great resource for current and evolving health events.
